Who Is HopSkipDrive

HopSkipDrive is a technology company that solves complex transportation challenges where there is a heightened need for safety, equity, and care. HopSkipDrive's marketplace arranges care-centered transportation across 13 states and Washington, DC, supplementing other transportation options by connecting kids, older adults, or anyone needing extra support, to highly-vetted caregivers on wheels, such as grandparents, babysitters, and nurses.

HopSkipDrive also builds software and offers advisory services that solve the biggest transportation challenges facing schools and school districts around the country, including budget cuts, bus driver shortages, and reaching climate goals. HopSkipDrive partners with more than 600 school districts, government agencies, and nonprofits. More than three million rides over 61 million miles have been completed through HopSkipDrive since the company was founded in 2014 by three working mothers.

In 2018, the Los Angeles County Department of Children and Family Services approached HopSkipDrive and asked for assistance in meeting the ESSA (Every Student Succeed Act) federal mandate of transporting students in the child welfare system to their schools of origin. From that point forward, HopSkipDrive shifted its focus to a model of filling in transportation gaps for families, schools, and county welfare offices.



Telematics

An industry leading third-party app records events of the six riskiest driving behaviors, including device use while driving, speeding, hard braking, rapid acceleration, hard turning, and collision detection. HopSkipDrive tracks the data on driving behavior and enable iterative improvement. CareDrivers receive information about their own driving patterns from the week before, along with resources on safe driving.

Legislative And Regulatory Advocacy

More than 53% of U.S. students today get to school in a personal vehicle. Due to a variety of factors including changing bell schedules, open enrollment practices, changes to walk boundaries, bus driver shortages, and many others, the needs of students today are more individualized than ever. Despite fewer students than ever being accommodated by the yellow school bus, it remains that most state regulations have only ever contemplated the yellow school bus model with some limited consideration of supplemental transportation services.

HopSkipDrive continues to advocate for the expansion of supplemental transportation methods and solutions for pupil transportation through legislative and regulatory efforts at the federal, state, and local levels. To that end, HopSkipDrive continues to advocate for the smart regulation of supplemental student transportation services, informed by data on safe driving practices, which balances safety with student equity and access.



How We Serve

HopSkipDrive promotes equitable access and develops solutions with community leaders to improve transportation access and mobility services to ensure that every child has safe and reliable transportation options, regardless of their background or geographic location.

- Youth Advisory Board: In 2024, HopSkipDrive launched its
 first ever Youth Advisory Board to directly hear from its
 student riders and stakeholders about ways to improve
 access for communities; And alleviate the challenges faced
 by working parents who may need assistance with
 transporting their children to and from school, extracurricular
 activities, and other appointments.
- Equitable Access To Transportation Advisory Council (EATAC): In 2024, 10 experts in safety, child welfare, education, community development, and equity convened to form The Equitable Access to Transportation Advisory Council (EATAC) is committed to improving transportation access, equity, and mobility by ensuring that all youth, regardless of socioeconomic status, race, or ability, have access to safe, affordable, and reliable transportation.
- HopSkipImpact: In 2023, the HopSkipImpact initiative was launched to create opportunity for all through mobility by offering access to discounted rides to eligible nonprofit organizations. We place great emphasis on living our values in all that we do, and we are dedicated to making a difference in the lives of the children and families we serve.
